Modest growth driven by organic, low-sugar spreads, with flexible plastic seeing a dynamic rise in packaging volumes Glass jars dominates sweet spreads packaging in Germany, but sees a declining share of packaging volumes Preference for organic, low-sugar spreads and raw material volatility drives change in sweet spreads

Healthier nut and seed based spreads and smaller pack sizes to fuel growth in sweet spreads packaging in Germany Glass jars will still dominate, but thin wall plastic containers expected to gain ground
